Qualifications

From 1982 to 2009, I practiced as a restorer and antiques dealer in Venice, Italy, collaborating with organizations and institutions, both public and private. I collaborated with the laboratory of Andrea Fedeli, Florence, 1984. From 1994 to 1999 I supported these activities with an Art Gallery in San Marco, San Samuele 3339. Venice.

Founder and President of the Cultural Association Zanipolo and of the Cultural Foundation SS. John and Paul in Venice, dealing with cultural event organization, in cooperation with private individuals, associations, organizations and institutions.

In the year 2000, teaching "Corso Fenice" in gilding, by the Veneto Region and the European Community for the project of reconstruction of the "la Fenice" Theater in Venice. I am currently working on the creation of a cultural project in Istria, within the Regional Law n.15 of 1994 for the conservation and enhancement of cultural manufacts of Venice and Veneto origin in the territory of Istria and Dalmatia

I have made for this the Ars et Labor, based in Porec, Istria, of which I am the director.

The Ars et Labor association, through the Project of Conservative Maintenance School, deals with conservation and enhancement of artistic manufacts of Venetian origins in the territory of Istria and Dalmatia, in the directives and with the purpose of the law n. 15-1994 of the Veneto Region.

It creates the possibility, for those who wishes to know these specific techniques and methods of intervention, to work together with those who by profession performs for decades in Venice the work of conservation.

It is not a school. It does not issues certifications or diplomas.

It is a project of cultural collaboration.

Once two or three sites have been chosen, we will identify parts of such artistic heritage as wooden or stone artifacts, paintings on various media, jewelry and silverware, fabrics, and everything else, strictly of Venetian artistic origin in the Istrian territory.

And on these real artifacts will begin operations of practical and theoretical conservative maintenance, preventive conservation and scheduled maintenance.

Introducing hand in hand, in the open working yard, methodologies ranging from cataloging to archiving with the aid of information technology, from science to technology of cultural heritage materials, methodology and technique of non-destructive or microdestructive investigations, with notions of chemistry and physics, theoretical and practical. And special meetings on the history of art and the territory, and on the interaction between environment and cultural heritage.

The possible alterations that these artifacts are subject to in the interaction with the environment, using the most advanced methods of materials science.

And compare the operational, management and planning of interventions apt to control and monitor the state of conservation of the artistic manufacts, in close collaboration with other professionals working on the field of the hosting country.

With meetings, open to all, moderated by experts of the Superintendency of Artistic Heritage and the University.

To explain problems and solutions.

Including those related to projects with European funding.

To a greater and greater involvement of all the different actors operating in this field.

The Project will start together with the individual sites.
